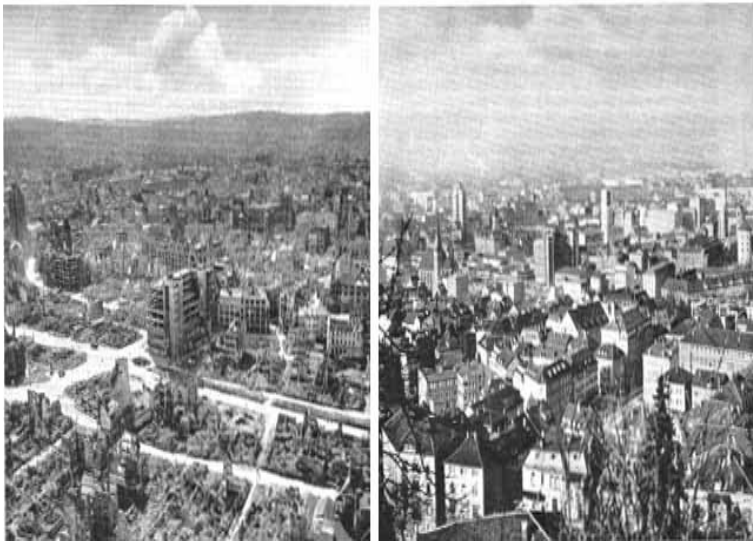


Reconstructing Europe after the Great War
